Carl Zander, FCCC Member does it again!

The following is a recent letter and article about Carl Zander, FCCC Member and President of Man Machine Interface. It is obvious that, again, our members are on the cutting edge of Corvette History!

To: MMI Vendors and Supporters

Please find enclosed a copy of the recent Performance Press article, from the Bowling Green Corvette Plant, ... concerning the acquisition and delivery of our 2007 C6 Z06.

This initiated our special Z06 high performance project being developed in conjunction with Tim Lally Chevrolet. Brake system upgrades, including cryogenically treated brake rotors, have been completed and are in the test phase. Engine and exhaust modifications are currently under development. The culmination of our project is to be able to offer to the C6 Z06 Corvette enthusiast a comprehensive performance package. MMI is dedicated to providing only the highest quality Corvette products and services to the Corvette community.

Accompanied by retiree Sonny Kilgo, Carl A. Zander and his wife Barbara visited the plant on a sunny day in December to watch their LeMans Blue Z06 make its way down our conveyor system. Zander, who bought his first Corvette in 1964 and currently has a ZR1 parked in the garage, has written detailed articles about our product for publications such as Corvette Enthusiast, Corvette Fever and Chevy High Performance. This new Z06, though, will stand out among the rest when all is said and done; it is the subject of a special high performance project being developed by Man Machine Interface, Inc., in conjunction with Tim Lally Chevrolet of Bedford, Ohio.

The project, adding a performance package to modify the Z06's induction and exhaust systems and reprogramming the LS7's engine control system specifically for the induction and exhaust system modifications, will add 35 to 40hp at the rear wheels -bringing the LS7 to a rated 550hp. As if that's not enough, Zander plans on even more changes, including a brake system upgrade to better handle the increased horsepower. Good call, Carl.

As Carl and his wife walked through the plant, they listened closely to Sonny's detailed explanations at each operation, and on occasion, an employee would take the time to explain a process or just welcome them. This attention left an impression on Zander and his wife. Here is an excerpt from a letter he sent after his fun-filled day:

"Thp expertise, master technical skills, professionalism and motivation exhibited by the employees I met were truly extraordinary. In addition, no matter where I was in the build process I was always greeted with 'Good morning!' or 'How are you?' or 'Glad you could come visit the plant!'-which made all of these employees feel like friends and neighbors."

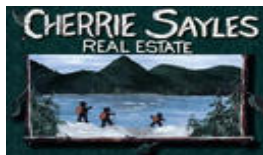
